

## **Post Operative Instructions- Denture**

The following post operative advice is intended to address potential questions or concerns you may have following your denture therapy. Should you have any further questions that have not been mentioned below please do not hesitate to contact our office.

- \* You will experience some discomfort for several days as the soft tissues adapt to the new denture. It is common to require several adjustments over the following few weeks until comfort and function is achieved.
  
- \* Dentures should be removed before retiring for the evening and soaked in a denture solution. Clean the dentures thoroughly before placing them back in your mouth.
  
- \* Speech may be altered initially and will adapt over the following 2-3 days as your muscles and tongue become accustomed to the new denture.
  
- \* Saliva flow is commonly increases as the mouth adapts to the new denture. This should subside within one week.
